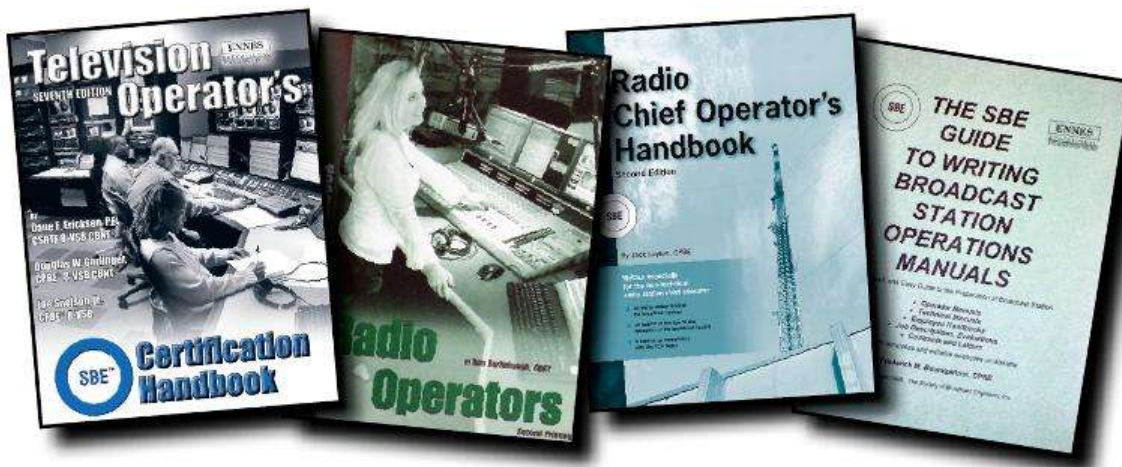

SBE 20-year level of certification



Last month I went over the certifications that require at least five or 10 years of broadcast engineering experience in order to qualify to take an SBE certification exam. This month, I want to let you know that if you have been in the broadcast engineering field for 20 or more years, then we have a certification for you.

If you already hold a senior certification or a Professional Electrical Engineer's license and have 20 years of service in broadcast or related technology, you may obtain Certified Professional Broadcast Engineer without taking an exam. Applicants must supply three letters of reference along with other backup material with the appropriate application.
